Established in 2000, the Survivor Scholarship program recognizes the triumphs of children who have overcome their cancer diagnosis and awards \$1,500 to post-secondary students who are pursuing their educational aspirations.

Eligibility Criteria

Canadian Citizen

- Applicants must be a Canadian citizen or permanent resident
- Applicants must be living in Canada

Academics

- Applicants must be entering any year of study in a post-secondary program
- Programs must be full-time and begin in Fall 2024

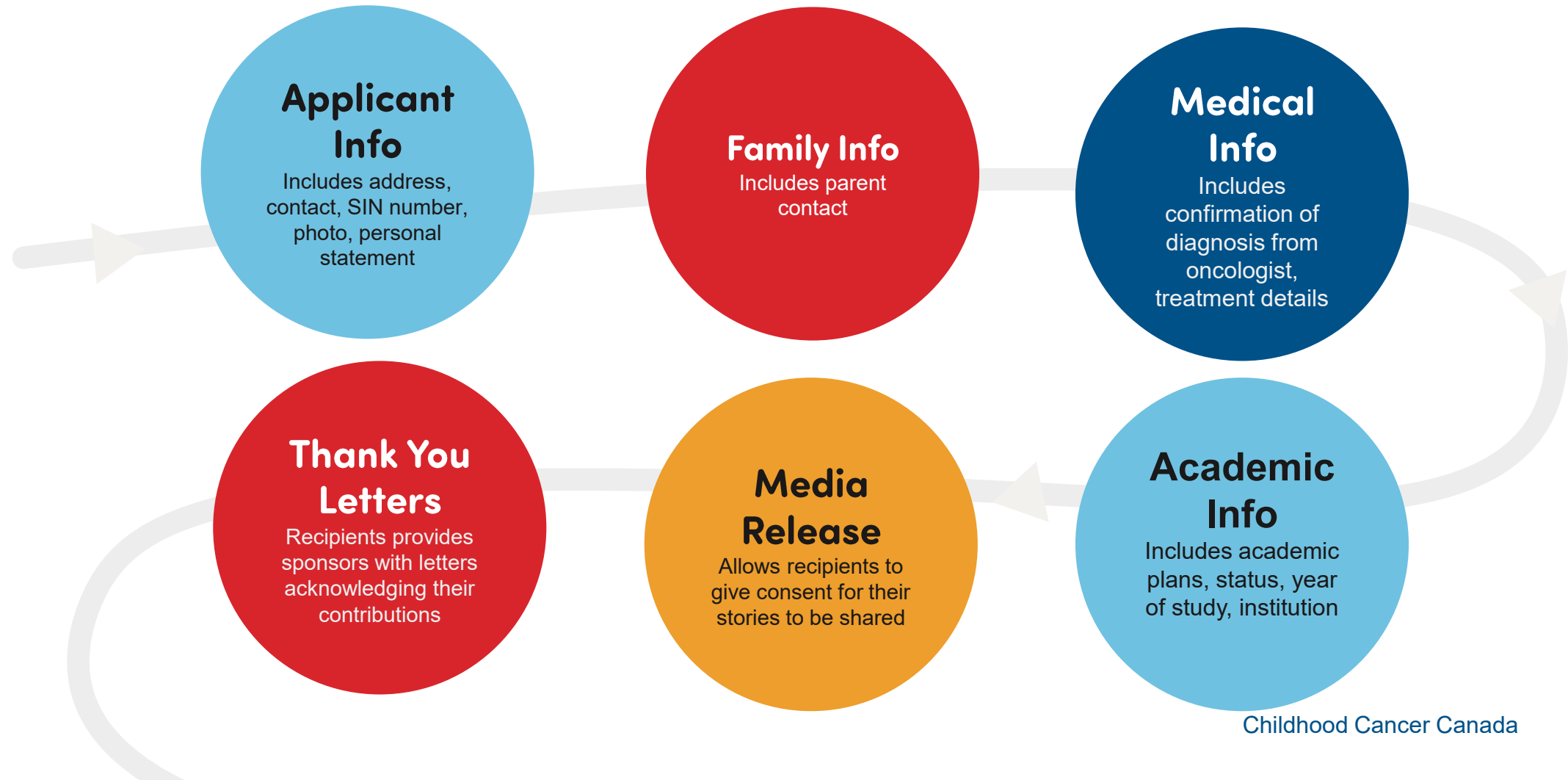
Pediatric Cancer

- Applicants must have been diagnosed with a pediatric cancer ON or BEFORE their 18th birthday

* Previous recipients ARE NOT eligible to receive subsequent scholarships *

Requirements

*The entire selection process takes up to 6 months, recipients receive their scholarships in October
